What Does ASETS Offer?

NCPEI's ASETS Funding Program offers financial assistance to Off-Reserve Aboriginals for:

- **Education**

(i.e. tuition, books, or living expenses)

*Up to 2 years of funding for College programs

*Only the final year of studies is funded for University programs

- **Wage Subsidy**

(i.e. work placement funding)

*Up to the first 6 months of employment can be funded



EDUCATION ASSISTANCE

ASETS provides financial assistance for Aboriginals to attend college or university programs, to increase their skill level and employability.



WAGE SUBSIDY

ASETS offers wage subsidy to employers to offer them an incentive to hire recent grads or those lacking in relevant work experience.

How To Apply for ASETS?



1) *Fill out an ASETS Application on the NCPEI Website:*

2) *Gather All Supporting Documents Necessary to Submit Application:*

- Proof of Aboriginal Ancestry
- Resume with (3) References
- Letter of Acceptance to training institution, or job offer/letter of intent to employ
- Printout or letter of training institution costs for tuition, books, fees and/or equipment supplies
- If you applied to your band first and were denied funding, please provide the rejection letter you received
