

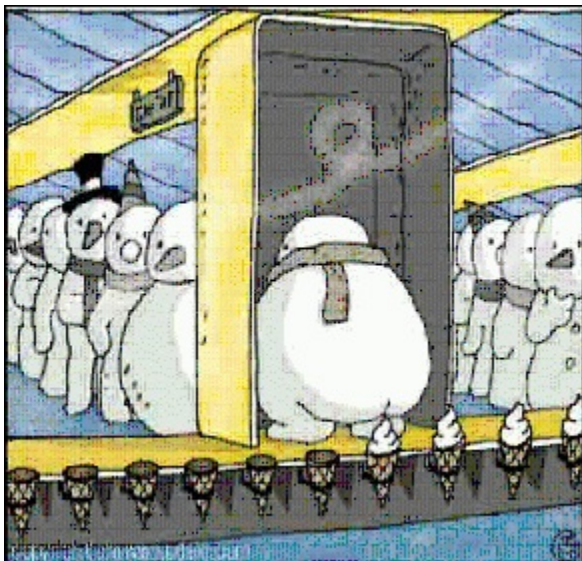
Youth Program
