Rules and Regulations Contract

Please read the following. Once you are finished please sign and submit with the rest of the Miss Aboriginal package.

- 1.) Respect is mandatory. Contestants found being disrespectful will be asked to leave the pageant. (this includes contestants, judges, spectators, volunteers, etc)
- 2.) There will be mandatory workshops the day before the pageant. Each contest will be required to participate.
- 3.) The evening before the pageant, all contestants will be invited to sleep over at the Native Council building. Should a contestant choose not to sleepover they will be required to return to the Native Council building for 9 am the following morning.
- 4.) Contestants are required to bring all necessary items (make-up, hair accessories, regalia, and equipment for talents) to the workshops the day before the pageant.
- 5.) Contestants will be required to wear an "evening dress" or "ball gown" for a part of the pageant. Should a contestant not have one or is unable to attain one they need to contact Jenna or Katie by March 1st 2010 @ 892-5314.
- 6.) **The title of Miss Aboriginal is a big responsibility. The winner of this pageant will be required to attend many functions through the NCPEI and within the community. Should Miss Aboriginal not follow through on her expectations she risks the chance of forfeiting her title.**
